St Florian 25th Anniversary - Steward Katie Babkoff

The event will be a feast celebrating the 25th Anniversary of St Florian becoming a barony and will be held on 25th July at Sunnybank Hall.

Our Feastocrat, Lauren Plant, is working on an idea for a pub-like game to organise the food, which will coincide with the trivia. This would involve wooden discs as coins, which the trivia teams can use to 'purchase' food items. Or pool to get a shared plate.

Nadya has confirmed that she'll be our bookings officer, with bookings opening after the Bazaar is concluded.

The event schedule includes:

- Opening and Closing Court
- Trivia
- Feast
- Stories from the B&Bs, all have indicated that they love the idea of providing stories, but are thinking about what they would like to contribute, so we will be in touch with them again, likely post Festival.
- A potential theatre act (TBC)

Event Costs:

- Fixed:
 - Hall hire: \$612
 - Refundable security deposit: \$1,000
 - Security guard: \$507
 - Site tokens: \$200
 - Contingency: \$200
- Variable:
 - Food: \$15/head
 - Kingdom levy: \$1.10pp
 - GST: \$283.64
- Income:
 - Adult members: \$40
 - Minor members 13-17: \$20
 - Minor members <12: Free

Total expenses: \$4,082.64

Total income: \$3,220 for an anticipated 80 adult attendees

Profit/Loss: -\$862.64, we are intentionally running this event at a loss to make it affordable for as many people as possible. (If the bond is refunded in full there will be a profit of \$137.36)
